④ If cancer is confirmed, the patient can get some support for medical expenses. (Cannot apply if you do not take the exam  
this year). However, patients with lung cancer receive medical expense support regardless of national cancer screening.

※ Age rules for cancer examinations: stomach cancer (over 40), breast cancer (females over 40), colon cancer (over 50), liver  
cancer (over 40 with high risk), cervical cancer (females over 20) and lung cancer (from 54 to 74 with high risk)

※ A person registered to the Benefit Extension Policy or who had a colonoscopy within five years can postpone the cancer  
screening.

※ You can check the screening recipient, screening agency, and annual screening result from the Web page of the National  
Health Insurance Service (**www.nhis.or.kr**).

※ If you hadn't been fasting for more than eight hours prior to the health checkup, if you had the night shift prior to the  
checkup, or if you were examined during your menstrual cycle, the result may be inaccurate. Please observe the health
